Family

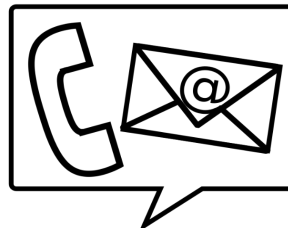
